



Coal Train are now delivering RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations as a Traineeship under the 2017-20 User Choice Program.

This qualification reflects the role of employees such as production operators in an open cut mine or quarry, who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

This qualification provides a pathway for entry level roles on a Queensland coal mine site.

### DURATION

The anticipated duration for this traineeship is 24 months. In some instances, the traineeship can be reduced. Trainees can be employed as full time or part time but not as a casual employee.

### STUDENT CONTRIBUTION FEE

Participants undertaking a traineeship will be required to pay student contribution fees. Student Contribution Fees are the non-government contribution for the cost of training and assessment services. These fees are set at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency and are paid on behalf of the participant by their employer or another third party. Partial exemptions and full exemptions of fees are available for participants who meet one or more of the exemption categories.

Partial exemption fees are available to eligible participants who meet one or more of the exemption categories.

Student Contribution Fees for RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extractions may vary according to the electives selected and if are any application exemptions with fees varying from \$340.00 to \$567.00.
