



Coal Train are now delivering SIT30616 Certificate III in Hospitality as a Traineeship under the User Choice Program 2017-20 Program.

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who have a range of well-developed hospitality service, sales or operational skills and sound knowledge of industry operations. Using discretion and judgement, they work with some independence and under limited supervision using plans, policies and procedures to guide work activities.

This qualification provides a pathway to work in organisations such as restaurants, hotels, motels, clubs, pubs, cafés, and coffee shops. This qualification allows for multiskilling and for specialisation in accommodation services, food and beverage and gaming.

### DURATION

The anticipated duration for this traineeship is 24 months. In some instances, the traineeship can be reduced. Trainees can be employed as full time and part time but not in a casual capacity.

### STUDENT CONTRIBUTION FEE

Participants undertaking a traineeship will be required to pay student contribution fees. Student Contribution Fees are the non-government contribution for the cost of training and assessment services. These fees are set at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency and are paid on behalf of the participant by their employer or another third party. Partial exemptions and full exemptions of fees are available for participants who meet one or more of the exemption categories.

Partial exemption fees are available to eligible participants who meet one or more of the exemption categories.

Student Contribution Fees for SIT30616 Certificate III in Hospitality may vary according to the electives selected and if are any application exemptions with fees varying from \$384.00 to \$640.00.
