- Be a permanent resident of Australia or a refugee and humanitarian visa holder
- Permanently reside in Queensland or be permanently employed in Queensland Funding is available for the following:
- Active Apprentices or Trainees
- Existing workers in the first year out of their Apprenticeship or Traineeship
- Unemployed existing worker for less than 12 months and in the first year out of their Apprenticeship or Traineeship
- Cancelled Apprentices or Trainees who are currently accessing State Government funding to complete their institution based training.
