To be eligible Participants must:

- Be an existing worker in the building and construction industry for at least one month with a continuous employer
- Be a permanent resident of Australia or a refugee and humanitarian visa holder
- Permanently reside in Queensland or be permanently employed in Queensland

Funding is also available for unemployed eligible workers who have not been unemployed for a period of not greater than four years.
