

# FSK10219 CERTIFICATE I IN SKILLS FOR VOCATIONAL PATHWAYS

This qualification is designed for individuals who need skills to prepare for a vocational pathway qualification or further foundation skills development.

It is suitable for individuals who require:

- a pathway to employment and further vocational training
- reading, writing, oral communication, learning and numeracy skills primarily aligned to the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF) Level 2
- entry level digital technology and employability skills
- education, training and employment goals.

11 units of competency including 1 core unit, plus 10 elective units. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

- up to 3 units may be selected from Group A, at least 5 units must be selected from Group B
- 2 units must be selected from any currently endorsed training package qualification or accredited course other than FSK and remaining units may be selected from the FSK training package or any currently endorsed training package qualification or accredited course.

## CAREER START FUNDING

### ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING:

Funding is available for this qualification if:

- The student is assessed as a disadvantaged learner (*faces barriers to training participation and requires additional support prior to enrolment in a certificate III vocational qualification*)
- It is approved for delivery as part of a project funded under Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW)
- Are aged 15 years or older and not enrolled in school
- Permanently reside in Queensland
- Are an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident, or eligible visa holder
- Have not completed a Certificate III or higher qualification in the past 10 years\*
- Are not currently enrolled in another qualification
- Meet any additional entry requirements listed in the Queensland Subsidised Training List

\*Exemptions apply for school qualifications and foundation skills courses.

### PAYMENTS

A contribution to the cost of training and assessment services – called a co-contribution fee – must be made by students undertaking a certificate III level vocational qualification and non-concessional students undertaking certificate I and/or II level vocational qualifications. Coal Train will charge a fee per student to be paid by the student or community group. This fee includes all costs for the training. Invoicing will incur at the completion of the intake.

### Co-contribution fees (per person):

Non-Concessional: \$150.00

Concessional: \$100.00

\* The above rate is based on training in the Yeppoon/ Rockhampton area.



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
